The main subject for discussion will be the markets and BP.

There is increasing pressure to pull the BP issue. Jim Baker has telephoned the Chancellor today, and apparently Greenspan ~~Span~~ has spoken to the Governor. (The Governor is coming back early to London to help advise.) Brian Griffiths has been contacted by one or two people from the United States, including a Senior Domestic Adviser at the White House. This is of course not surprising.
